1.0	<p>Replacement Bridge The bridge appears to be in place following the recent flooding.</p> <p>There has been no response from the two contractors (Brian Swales and J Thackeray & Sons Ltd) approached for the bridge repair work. Progress quotations.</p>	MB
2.0	<p>Recovery of Records Following the last meeting Sarah Oswald has not responded to a request to recover records covering the Board Walk project. Follow up with a further request.</p>	PE
3.0	<p>Friends of Lady Spring Wood Flooding and Covid 19 pandemic have prevented any progress.</p> <p>Mike & Janice Gwilliam have expressed an interest in improving the signage at Orchard Fields and the Roman Fort. They have been referred to the MTC Clerk to discuss possible grant funding.</p> <p>Lady Spring Wood is leased from the Fitzwilliam Estate. Make contact with the new Fitzwilliam agent when she takes up her post after the 4th March.</p> <p>Following the Covid pandemic the Ryedale Community Support Organisation have a bank of new volunteers. Arrange to meet the organisers.</p> <p>Approach the County Hall Countryside Service through Janice Gwilliam for potential help with volunteers.</p>	MB MB/ML MB
4.0	<p>Cycle Path Project A request to the Police Commission's Safety Fund for a grant of £20k for a cycle path between Malton & Hovingham resulted in an award of £5,600. NYCC Highways Authority are not available for support and it is proposed to use the grant to commission consultants to complete a design, specification and cost estimate with a view to using the information to raise further grants for the construction.</p> <p>A condition of the grant is no monies are spent on VAT. Approach Malton Town Council and Swinton Parish Council with a view to using them to recover the VAT.</p> <p>Also approach RDC with a similar view to recovery of the VAT.</p> <p>If the Councils are unable to recover the VAT a contribution of £250 towards the cost to be made from MNAP funds.</p>	MB MB/ML
5.0	<p>Finances MNAP current account stands at £2,096.06 £1,000 to be ring fenced for payment to MTC for the Fitzwilliam annual lease.</p> <p>The Portas Fund is held by RDC and is believed to have some £3,900 unspent. Approach RDC to confirm the value and with a view to transferring the fund to MNAP.</p>	MB/ML
